Distance from San Rafael Bridge to mouth of Petaluma River: 12 nm
Distance from mouth of Petaluma River to Petaluma turning basin: 12 nm
Clearance under Highway 37 overpass: 70 feet at MLLW. (Same as Benicia RR Bridge.)
Channel depth 8' to 11' MLLW. Tidal current 1.5 knots. Prevailing wind from NNW
